

1. Bereavement Pathway triggered- Using the enter new note feature search for '**Bereavement Pathway**'



2. Complete relevant sections as required depending on stage of process e.g. detection, admission, discharge. Save and close form when required documentation completed. This will generate the Sands tear drop icon on the pregnancy summary so that anyone accessing the patient record can see that the bereavement pathway has been triggered.
3. On admission-Labour and birth documentation should be completed on Badger as normal. See user guide for labour and birth documentation.
4. Complete birth registration process for registerable births to get NHS number and MRN number for baby. This includes completing the baby demographics note to record other details to include birthweight, sex etc. E-Record processes for encounter to be completed as per current process.
5. Then search for '**baby bereavement pathway**' using the enter new note feature to complete the rest of the bereavement pathway documentation for baby in Badger.
6. Complete referrals and send electronically via Badger to include: (see referrals user guide)

 8. Ensure both bereavement pathways have been completed prior to discharge
