- 1. Log in with computer user name and password
- 2. Find patient using NHS number only
- 3. Select the **Notes during Pregnancy tab** on the left-hand side. The assessment should already be opened by the midwife in the notes during pregnancy timeline
- 4. Click onto assessment from today and select add new note (pick from list) or use 'enter new note' to search for note required



## Common forms that will be required:

- Observations- make sure type of observations is selected as MEOW's
- Blood tests and results
- Microbiological tests and results
- Fluid outputs/intake
- Manual handling assessment
- Pressure ulcer risk assessment 'Braden score'
- Covid 19 assessment
- Vascular access device/urinary catheter removal
- Clinical note- free text note for any conversations. For example 'offered refreshments'

- 4. Use 'enter new note' to search for note required

- Observations- make sure type of observations is selected as MEOW's
- Blood tests and results
- Microbiological tests and results
- Fluid outputs/intake
- Manual handling assessment
- Pressure ulcer risk assessment 'Braden score'
- Covid 19 assessment
- Vascular access device/urinary catheter removal
- Clinical note- free text note for any conversations. For example 'offered refreshments'

#### Theatre cases- c/section

- Complete Surginet information as per current workflow
- Open up 'Operation' note within Badger and complete timings. For example date and time knife to skin, date and time of birth if required to do so
- Complete: operating surgeon, additional operating surgeon, scrub nurse(s) if required to do so

Obstetric emergencies- if asked to be the scribe use enter new note feature to search for:

- PPH
- Fetal shoulder dystocia
- Fetal cord prolapse
- Maternal cardiac arrest/collapse
- Fetal Breech birth

Enter timings and people present where required and any other additional information. This will be completed in full by the midwife or obstetric team.

If scribing for an instrumental delivery- use enter new note to search for 'fetal instrumental/operative birth'. Complete timings where applicable. This will be completed in full by the obstetric team.

### Postnatal support workers and nursery nurses

- 1. Log in with computer user name and password
- 2. Find patient using NHS number only
- 3. Assessment should already be opened by the midwife in the Postnatal timeline
- 4. Click onto assessment from today and add new note (pick from list) or use 'enter new note' to search for note required



## **Commons forms:**

#### Mother

- Observations (mother)
- Blood tests and results
- Microbiological tests and results
- Fluid outputs/intake
- Manual handling assessment
- Pressure ulcer risk assessment 'Braden score'
- Covid 19 assessment
- Vascular access device/urinary catheter removal (cannula/catheter removal)
- Clinical note- free text note for any conversations. For example 'offered refreshments'
- Postnatal conversations- feeding discussion/checklist

#### **Baby**

- Observations- baby temp and oxygen sats
- Feeding update- to record feed amount/duration
- Feeding assessments
- Feeding plan
- Breastfeeding observation checklist
- Expressing assessment
- Postnatal education- for cord care, bathing, eye care discussions
- Postnatal conversations- how to express, making up feds etc
- Safe sleeping assessment
- Parenting observations
- Blood tests and results (baby)- for example blood glucose, SBR, day 5 heel prick
- Microbiological tests and results- for example swabs
- Transcutaneous bilirubin test

**Obstetric emergencies**- if asked to be the scribe use enter new note feature to search for:

- PPH
- Maternal cardiac arrest/collapse

Enter timings and people present where required and any other additional information. This will be completed in full by the midwife or obstetric team.
