



Treatment options if you experience preterm birth (before 37 weeks)

Place of Birth

If your baby is very early, we can help get you to the right hospital who provide specialist care for very early babies

Steroids

Improve survival rates by reducing the risk of lung disease, brain bleeds, bowel problems and infections if given to the mother before the baby is born

Magnesium Sulphate

Reduces the risk of conditions which affect the babies movement and coordination if given to the mother before the baby is born

Antibiotics

Help to reduce the risk of infection if given to the mother before the baby is born

Cord Management

Caring for the umbilical cord in a particular way which reduces the risk of brain bleeds and the need for a blood transfusion

Keeping your baby warm

Putting your baby in a specially designed cot which manages their temperature and reduces the risk of death, brain bleeds, bowel conditions and infection

Maternal Breast Milk

We can help you express breastmilk before or after birth which is the safest milk for early babies and reduces the chance of infection and bowel problems
