












The table below identifies **All** current icons used for Patient Status Alerts across **NUTH**

Name of Alert	Icon	Purpose / Trigger
Accessible Information Patient Status Alert		Flag is triggered by codes in the Accessible Information template. Move your mouse pointer over the Accessible Information icon within the patient's demographics box to view the Read codes, which triggered the alert.
Identified Additional Needs		The flag is triggered when the assessment of need box is ticked on the Additional needs template within the 0-19 service.
At Risk of FGM		The flag is triggered when the Read code 'at risk of FGM' is added to the patients record.
Carbapenemase producing Enterobacteruacea (CPE)		The flag is triggered when the code Carbapenemase producing Enterobacteruacea is added to the record by the infection control template.
Clostridium Difficile		The flag is triggered when the Read code Clostridium difficile is added to the record by the infection control template.
Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)		The flag is triggered when the Read code is added to the record. CHIS are responsible for adding and removing this flag.
Healthy Child Pathway - Adult		The flag is triggered by the 0 -19 service to identify when an adult is on the Healthy Child Pathway.
Healthy Child Pathway - Child		The flag is triggered by the 0 -19 service to identify when a child is on the Healthy Child Pathway.
Lone Worker Risk		The flag is triggered by the outcome recorded on the Lone Worker Risk assessment template available Trustwide part of the Safety Assessment Dashboard.

MRSA		The flag is triggered when the Read code MRSA is added to the record by the infection control template.
Multidrug Resistant Organism		The flag is triggered when the Read code Multidrug Resistant Organism is added to the record by the infection control template.
Patient on Care of Next Infant Programme		The flag is triggered by the 0 -19 service to identify when a child is on the Care of Next Infant Programme.
Patient on Early Help Plan		The flag is triggered by the 0 -19 service or Family Hub to identify when a patient is on an Early Help Plan.
Patient Reports FGM		This flag is triggered when the Read code 'Patient reports FGM' is added to the record.
Patient subject to MARAC		The flag is triggered by the 0 -19 service to identify when a patient is subject to MARAC.
Person at risk		The flag is triggered by the 0 -19 service to identify when a patient is at risk of sexual, criminal exploitation, slavery or human trafficking.
Unborn Baby Subject to Child Protection Plan		The flag is triggered by the 0 -19 service to identify when an unborn baby is subject to a child protection plan.

The table below identifies some key **National** Patient Status Alerts used across **All** SystemOne services.

Name of Alert	Icon	Purpose
Active RTT Pathway		This flag shows if a patient has an open RTT period added before yesterday.
CP-IS		Child Protection Information Sharing (CP-IS) safeguarding information is available.
Looked After Child (LAC)/Child in Care		This flag is added and removed from the record when the appropriate codes are documented on the patients record indicating that they are a child in care.

Loss of Baby		This flag indicates that the patient has suffered a stillbirth, neonatal or infant death.
On Waiting List		The flag is triggered when the patient is on a waiting list.
Palliative Care Register		This flag is added and removed from the record when the appropriate codes are documented on the patients record, indicating they are on the palliative care register.
Patient is Deceased		This flag indicates the patient is deceased.
Patient On a Protection Plan		This flag indicates the patient is currently on a protection plan.
Patient Removed from Protection Plan		This flag indicates that the patient was previously on a protection plan.
Patient Pregnant		This flag indicates the patient is currently pregnant.
Patient Wait		This flag indicates that the patient has an open 18 week wait.
Patient's Birthday		This flag indicates that it is the patient's birthday.
Record Incomplete		This flag indicates that there is some data in the patient's record that cannot be viewed due to sharing rules.
Safeguarding information exists without ever having been on a child protection		This flag indicates information is recorded in the Safeguarding node however this patient is not on a child protection plan and has never been on a child protection plan.
Sharing In consent not recorded		This flag indicates no sharing in consent/dissent has been recorded for this patient. Data recorded at other organisations may not be visible.
Special Notes (c)		This flag indicates that the patient has a special note

Tool tip:

Please note if there is a line visible between the alerts it is there to separate the icons:



- Icons to the **left** of the line are national alerts and are available to all services that use SystemOne.
- Icons to the **right** of the line are available to all NUTH services, they will not be visible to the GP. Other icons visible outside of the list above will be specific to the service you work for and not visible to any other service.

Placing your cursor over each Patient Status Alert in the Demographics box will provide details about the alert.
